Description:	<p>The American Physical Society Conference for undergraduate women in physics is a three-day regional conference for undergraduate physics majors. It takes place each year at multiple sites throughout the US and Canada.</p> <p>The goal of the Conference is to help undergraduate women continue in physics by providing them with the opportunity to experience a professional conference, information about graduate school and professions in physics, and access to other women in physics of all ages with whom they can share experiences, advice, and ideas.</p> <p>A typical program will include research talks by faculty, panel discussions about graduate school and careers in physics, presentations and discussions about women in physics, laboratory tours, student research talks, a student poster session, and several meals during which presenters and students interact with each other.</p> <p>These conferences are disseminated through LinkedIn and financial assistance is provided.</p>
