During a six month period young women can attend the connected courses in STEM and learn more about daily student life. The participants also have an opportunity to gain practical experience in partner companies. After the course the participants get a Zdi-Campus-certificate that they can add to their curriculum vitae. The project led many young women who have attended these classes, to select one of the STEM fields for their further study.
