


Title:	M. Hildred Blewett Fellowship
Implementation	
Field(s) of Action:	* Presence and visibility
Objectives:	* Retention of women physicists in the scientific career and avoid the leaky-pipeline * Prevent horizontal segregation in the scientific career
Target Group(s):	Women researchers
Description:	<p>The award was established from a generous bequest from M. Hildred Blewett, an accelerator physicist who died in 2004. Hildred Blewett was passionate about physics and wanted to help women overcome obstacles by establishing the fellowship.</p> <p>To enable women to return to physics research careers after having had to interrupt those careers. The fellowship consists of a one-year award of up to \$45,000 (applicants can apply in a subsequent year for one additional year of support). Allowed expenses include dependent care (limited to 50% of the award), salary, travel, equipment, and tuition and fees. Overhead charges by the institution are not allowed.</p>
